Submit the application included in this mailer before October 31. Ballots begin mailing 20 days before the election.

### Vote early in-person

Visit any in-person advance voting location to cast your ballot. No application is necessary. Advance voting starts Saturday, October 28.

### Vote on Election Day

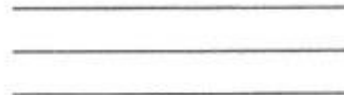
Polls will open at 7 a.m. and close at 7 p.m. on November 7, 2023. You must visit your assigned polling place.

## Reminder:

Returning this application for an advance ballot by mail will cause a ballot to be mailed to you 20 days before the election. If you then choose to vote in person, you will be required to vote a provisional ballot.

Ballots cannot be mailed to voters more than 30 days before the election. Completed applications must be received at the Election Office by Oct. 31 in order to be processed. False statement on this affirmation is a severity level 9, non-prison felony.
